

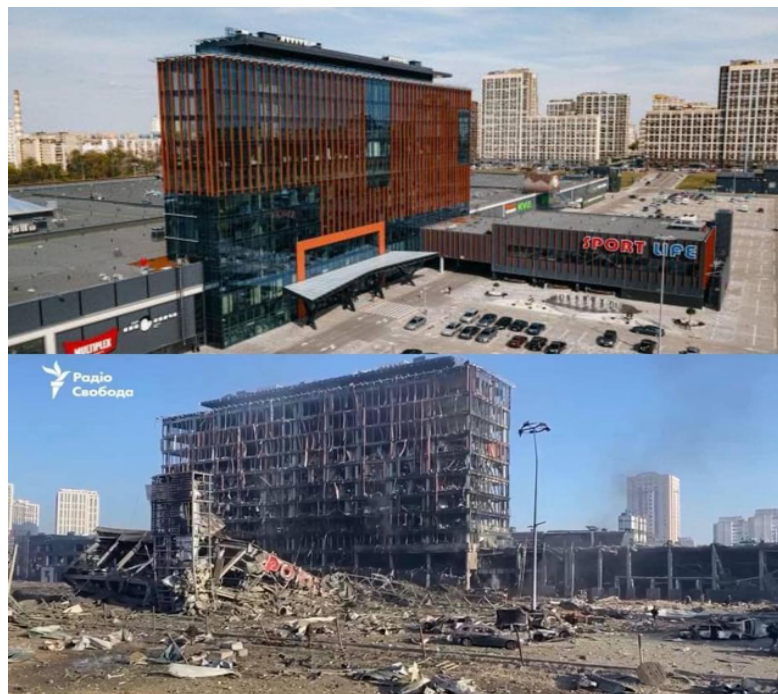
EURASIA NORTH FIELD REPORT:

Greetings dear Partners in Ministry. Below I'm sharing an updated report about the situation in Ukraine.

There still the last two Nazarene Pastors staying in Kiev and helping the remaining Nazarenes which stayed behind. During my last chat with him; he explained me they are working to be sure the families have access to supplies. Andriy is driving to Vinnitsya or other cities in western Ukraine to purchase food, water and medicines. Last few days they have been trying to buy an used van to bring more supplies to Kiev.

From Andriy:

This is a fresh update of bombing of Kyiv yesterday. Just found this video on the news. This is not far away from Первая Церковь Назарянина (first Church of the Nazarene) I remember our last two meetings in this mall. First time we met there with our new missionaries. We were full of hopes and dreams for our churches and possible new ministry ideas. Another meeting was second was with some of our church leaders and their friends where they shared their heart about the new church plant ideas. This was a newly built and really nice new development. Many families were coming there with their kids, because many new families moved to live there in their new apartments. Well. Now it is all gone. Just one bomb and many plans and dreams destroyed. It is devastating. War is ugly. We were just sitting in the house of Sergiy and talked about the possibility to deliver food and other supplies to families living in that area this week. Our plans still stand, but the reality on the ground changes by minute.

If you see the Ukraine Flag is has two colors; it is light blue the upper part and yellow the lower part. If you have been in Ukraine you will understand the meaning of these colors when you are in the gigantic sunflower fields in a beautiful summer day. The picture is emblematic of soldiers attacking the vulnerable and fragile

Pastor Sergey from Mariupol.

Few years ago, we used to have a church in the city of Mariupol. Today the church is under another name but there still some connection with pastor Sergey. I'm sharing one of his last posts about the situation of the city. From all the cities the Russian Army have tried to take and control (without success), one is Kharkiv and the other is Mariupol. These two cities have been practically leveled down by the Russians killing hundreds or maybe thousands of civilians. The truth will only be known once this tragedy is over. Schools, hospitals have been targeted. The latest news showed a theater where more than 300 people were sheltered and the word Children were written in Russian in both sides of the building. The theater was bombed killing all people in it.

Ukraine. Day 27 there is a war. Russian armed forces mercilessly bomb cities, homes are being destroyed, people are dying. We are doomed to destruction. Blockade Mariupol became a bright illustration of the helplessness of the world community, in front of the prevailing evil.

**BUT THERE IS GOD! I declare with confidence: EVIL WILL BE CONFUSED!
PEOPLE SPILLING INNOCENT BLOOD, WILL BE DESTROYED.**

A people who raised a tyrant and supported his bloody evils will divide his portion. For thus says the Lord:

Isaiah 13:11: "I will punish the world for evil, and the wicked for their lawlessness, and will put an end to the highness of the proud, and will destroy the arrogance of the oppressors;"

Mothers who have lost their sons, wives who have lost their husbands, children who have lost their fathers, cheer up! You will be comforted by God. We pray and trust in him!
